Thanks to Alumni and friends we have installed new outdoor lighting along the sidewalk going from the LPC fitness center to the Ad building.

Adding 14 more lights would allow us to connect up to the cafeteria and out to the chapel. This will bring light to our previously dark sidewalks and make our campus both safer and more attractive at night.

The electrical conduit has already been run and concrete pads have been poured to make way for the additional lights. We need your help purchase the new light poles and professional install them.

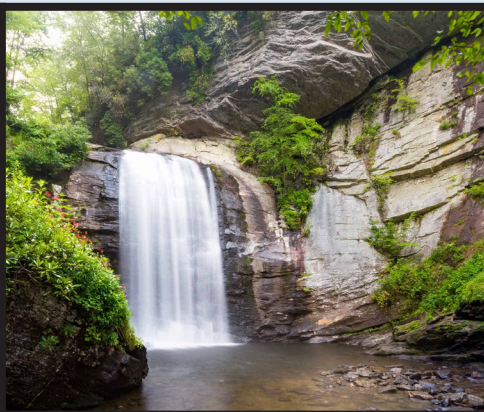
