Why (Supports Mission & Vision in the following ways):

- Fletcher Park Inn is a place to “Live with Purpose” in an independent living community near to vibrant, active church families, a large AdventHealth community presence including a regional hospital across the street, and the Fletcher Academy Campus, offering physical, mental, social, and spiritual Food for Life. We desire to create and maintain a community of residents who are engaged stakeholders of our mission and ministry, where each resident is able to fulfill a greater purpose by being involved with the schools, businesses, and ministries of Fletcher Academy, Inc. Ministries. The community itself should be a haven which provides safe, affordable, attractive

spaces that support body, mind, and spirit by offering a dynamic, fulfilling, peaceful, and compelling place to visit, spend time, and call home during a special part of life.

- We also seek to fully utilize a vitally important ministry owned by the organization to offer a strong value proposition (Villas, Apartments, and Rentals) where residents are called to Live with Purpose. This supports the practice of good stewardship of our land and building assets to generate revenue that supports the overall mission and sustainability of our organization.
- Fletcher Park Inn is a vital part of a Fletcher Academy education, which features an integrated work-study program as an essential component of its curriculum. Students work nearly everywhere on our campus, building practical skills and developing a strong work ethic as they are trained and mentored by caring, knowledgeable, patient, and kind supervisors who help to encourage each student on their teams to “Find your Purpose.”
- Fletcher Park Inn is home to our residents during a special time of life. Housekeeping services are one of the critical “touchpoints” which offer an opportunity to differentiate our Christian Seventh-day Adventist values in our community in a tangible way. Housekeeping is not viewed as “a job” here; being a Community Housekeeping Specialist is a ministry, not only in providing cleanliness, but also in being a leader/mentor of the student work program and a caring heart for residents’ needs and desires. The right team fit will have a strong desire for serving our Creator God, display attributes which emphasize order, cleanliness, and uncommon attention to detail, a Christlike love of people of all ages and walks of life, and a respect of our residents’ preferences for their closest environs (their homes), and a passion for working alongside young people.

How (Essential Duties and Responsibilities):

- **Displays** a strong desire for serving our Creator God through personal service, diligently working alongside students to promote attributes which emphasize order, cleanliness, and uncommon attention to detail.
- **Cleans** resident apartments, common areas, hallways, and exterior areas of the Fletcher Park Inn main building (clubhouse), including vacuuming, dusting, sweeping, mopping hard surfaces, and providing general cleaning in apartment bathrooms, kitchens, and detail cleaning of baseboards, moldings, doors, windows, and trim, fixturing, and more.
- **Helps** to maintain the residents’ environment by changing bed linens upon request, sending flat linens to laundry, and delivering cleaned linens.
- **Ensures** that waste / refuse containers are emptied frequently and kept clean.
- **Readies** guest rooms for families and guests of Fletcher Park Inn.
- **Maintains** interior cleanliness of motor vehicles, including a small coach and automobile used to transport residents to appointments and social events, shopping trips, etc.
- **Corrects** minor maintenance needs by changing light bulbs as required, etc.
- **Assists** with laundry services to include Food Service Department cleaning rags, aprons, uniform shirts, mops, etc.
- **Leads** by example, demonstrating proper cleaning techniques and helping to supervise student workers to ensure cleaning and housekeeping tasks are being performed properly with the highest standards in mind.
- **Demonstrates** genuine, authentic care for the needs and desires of others, working with the residents and Housekeeping Team Leader to address any concerns with services being

performed by the team and/or conditions of the residents' physical home environment which can be affected by the team's performance of its role.

- **Prioritizes** laundry, trash collection and cleaning tasks as needed to support the team's daily goals as set forth by the Team Leader, fully engaging with students to utilize their labor as a force multiplier.
- **Conscientiously maintains** department storage areas to a high standard of cleanliness and organization.
- **Maintains** standards of work, sanitation, and safety.
- **Upholds and supports** Fletcher Academy and Fletcher Park Inn standards pertaining to dress code, disciplinary actions, Student Handbook guidelines, etc., recording and reporting any disciplinary or performance issues to the Housekeeping Team Leader or (in their absence) the Director or their designee for follow-up.
- **Willing and able** to be part of a dynamic, diverse team serving in a drug/alcohol/tobacco-free campus workplace environment.

What (Qualifications):

- High school diploma or equivalent preferred, possessing the skills necessary to communicate with residents, families, students, visitors, and guests.
- Some professional or private-duty custodial / housekeeping experience with a positive record of service, previous supervisory experience a plus.
- May stand, walk, stoop, or perform manual physical labor of varying intensity (mild to moderate) for extended periods. Lifting requirements < 50 lbs.
- Able to handle a high-paced, potentially stressful work environment, and make productive decisions to prioritize tasks.

Who (Reports to / Supervises):

- Reports to the Housekeeping Team Leader, may indirectly supervise student workers and/or Career Education class students.

Expectations:

- The mission drives everything we do; students and patrons are central to that.
- We collaborate with team members to put the best of the organization first.
- We are supportive of others and open to their ideas.
- We focus on God and work towards unity.
