Students work nearly everywhere on our campus, building practical skills and developing a strong work ethic as they are trained and mentored by caring, knowledgeable, patient, and kind supervisors who help to encourage each student on their teams to "Find your Purpose."
- Fletcher Park Inn is home to our residents during a special time of life. Our resident services, including courtesy transportation, are one of the critical "touchpoints" which offer an opportunity to differentiate our Christian Seventh-day Adventist values in our community in a tangible way. Being a shuttle driver is not viewed as "a job" here; it's part of a ministry, not only in providing safe, efficient, and reliable transportation to medical appointments and other essential errands, but also in being a caring heart for residents' needs and desires. The right team fit will have a strong desire for serving our Creator God, display attributes which emphasize care for residents' needs, safe operation of a motor vehicle, a Christlike love of people, and a passion for working with seniors.

How (Essential Duties and Responsibilities):

- **Operates** a company-owned passenger vehicle with safety as the primary concern, observing and adhering to all applicable traffic laws.
- Provides door-to-door service for residents with off-campus medical appointments and other essential errands.
- **Escorts** residents to appointments or returns as arranged, at the resident's preference.
- **Maintains** availability to respond to requests for transportation based on a pre-arranged schedule provided by the Fletcher Park Inn Receptionist and/or Business Office.
- **Seeks** opportunities to assist others by offering to help with loading and unloading of personal property, wheelchairs, canes, walkers, etc.
- Willing and able to be part of a dynamic, diverse team serving in a drug/alcohol/tobacco-free campus workplace environment.

What (Qualifications):

- High school diploma or equivalent preferred, possessing the skills necessary to communicate with residents, families, students, visitors, and guests.
- Must be able to safely operate a motor vehicle and assist senior residents of differing ambulatory abilities with their transportation needs (including loading and unloading of personal affects).
- Prior driving experience is not required, but candidate must be demonstrably mature and have a
 positive record of service and have a clean MVR (moving violation record) with no recent at-fault
 accidents or guilty / no contest moving violations and pass a background screening.
- May sit / stand for extended periods and walk, bend, stoop, or perform manual physical labor of varying intensity (mild to moderate) for brief periods. Lifting requirements less than 40 lbs.

• Previous professional driving / chauffeuring experience is a strong plus; possession of (or ability to acquire) a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) would also be desirable.
